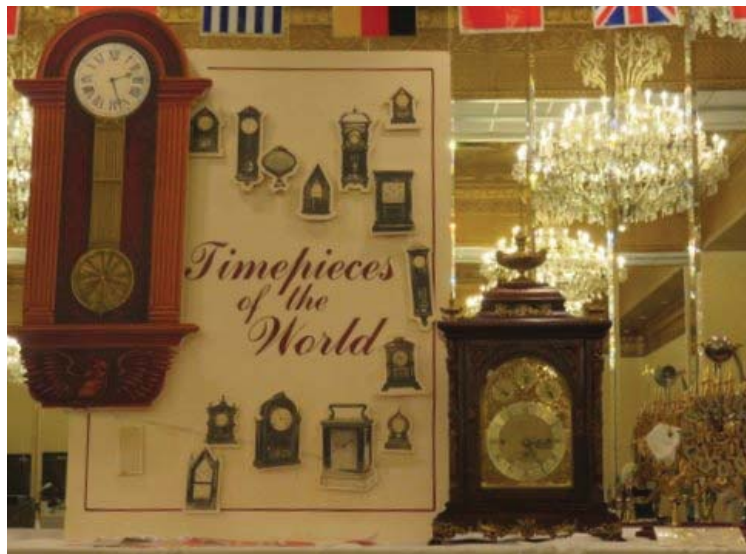


2015 is upon us and in full swing. I hope each of you had a Joyous and Merry Christmas and Happy New Year, and like me, am glad it's over for another year.

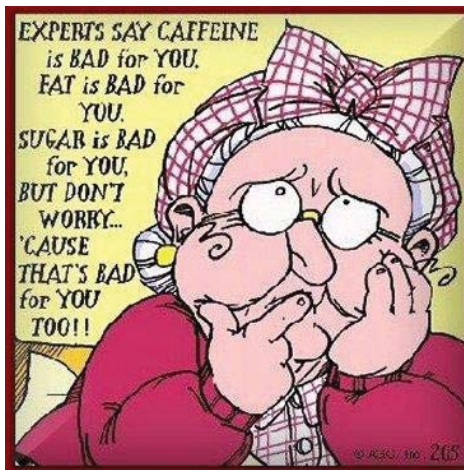
Buses stop in bus stations. Trains stop in train stations. Work is on my desk(workstation).....need I say more?
