Nick Bonura became a member of NAWCC and Creole Chapter #43 in 1976. His primary interests have been in the collecting and restoration of antique clocks. Nick also enjoys the fellowship and life long friendships he has made among many of the Creole members.

Over the 40+ years of his membership, Nick has held every office within the Creole chapter and has given numerous programs and workshops at chapter meetings and regional conventions. He was the General Chairman of the NAWCC National Conventions hosted in New Orleans by Creole Chapter in 1990 and again in 2001. The 2001 National Convention was held in the Louisiana Superdome during which 2,500 NAWCC members attended and 1,000 mart tables full of clocks and watches covered the entire Superdome football field.

Nick has also served as an NAWCC National Director, as an Awards Committee member, and as Chairman of the NAWCC Convention Committee. He was selected to be an NAWCC FELLOW and later a STAR FELLOW.
